

As the son of Danes immigrant to the UK in the 1930's, I thought I had a working knowledge of Danish History up to WWII. Surprise! Jespersen's presentation of a series of topics from the XVIth Century through to the beginning of the XXIst puts things together succinctly and clearly. This is an

engrossing book: I found it too stimulating for bedtime reading. Pulls no punches (gulp!) about the diminution in Denmark's prestige and power from the days of Canute's empire in the XIth Century, but gives an account of the sense of public duty and service the average member of that country has inbuilt in psyche and society, with both of which I resonate. 'Tak skal du ha'! My children, whether in the UK or USA will get a copy of this book for Christmas!

This actually a well written book that is focused on the political history of Denmark, not what I was looking for. The title implied a book on the full history of this country, where they came from who they are and what their customs are. Instead it curses on what it means to be 'Danish' in political and social terms and how that consciousness developed.

This is an unusually objective narration of the previous 500 years of Danish history. It is clearly written and concise.
