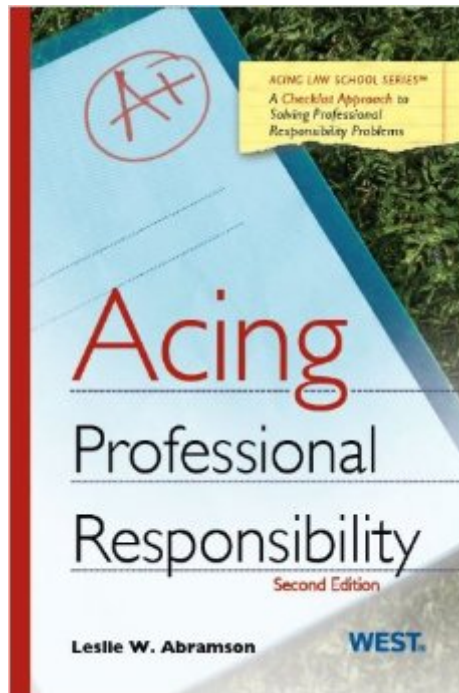


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# Acing Professional Responsibility (Acing Series)

Then if I knew my professor went over a rule a lot of times I also read the annotations and read the section of this Acing book that corresponded to that rule. After that I did as many practice problems as I could and timed myself while I did them and re-read the rule and the annotations of a particular rule if I got any of the practice problems wrong that were related to that particular rule. Most of these questions are common sense, so just use that logical reasoning that got you into law school! Don't completely blow off studying though, because your professor will definitely try to use some trick questions that

are very rule-specific. Good luck!
