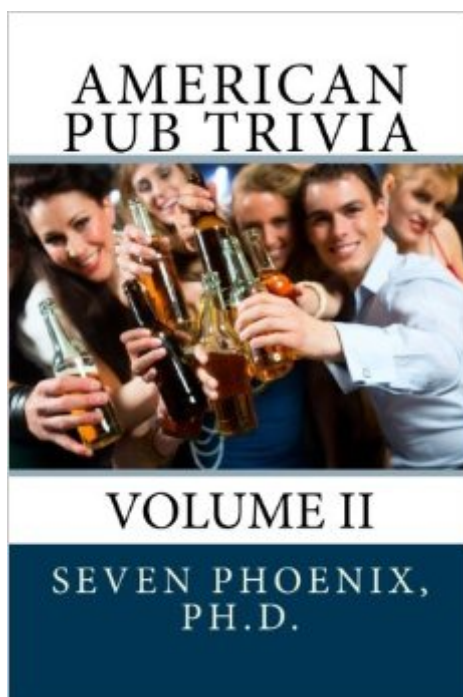

The questions range from simple things most people know to difficult or little-known facts about nearly anything. The layout is easy to navigate, with ten questions on a main topic, followed by a page of answers. Needless to say, I peeked at the answers more often than I should have. All-in-all, I found *American Pub Trivia* incredibly addicting, plus it provided a couple of hours of fun with my family. This was a surprisingly heavy volume and well-worth the price. Highly recommended for anyone who loves pub trivia or just wants to know it all.
